Pray the Divine Mercy Novena of Chaplets. A novena is typically nine days of prayer in preparation of a celebration of a feast day. For the Divine Mercy Novena the Chaplet is

recited perpetually at the Hour of Great mercy-three o'clock pm. (If possible) Jesus specifically asked that the chaplet be recited as a novena. He promised, "By this Novena (of Chaplets), I will grant every possible grace to souls."
