## Caring for those who always cared for us!



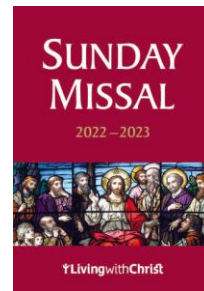

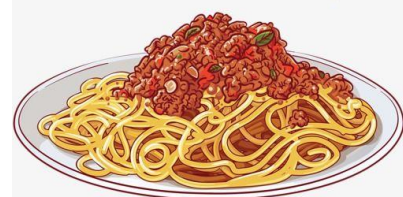
