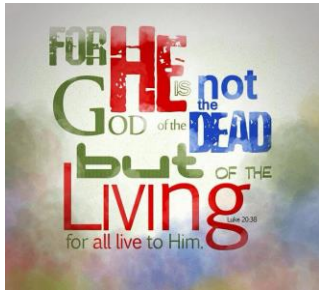

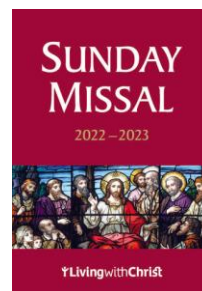


Caring for those who always cared for us!

FINANCIAL DONATIONS FOR 2022

All financial donations made to the Parishes are credited to the year that they are received by the church and NOT according to the date on the cheque or the envelope. If you wish to make additional donations this year, please ensure that they are received in the parish office before December 29, 2022. This will guarantee that they will be deposited before the end of the calendar year. They will then be added to your tax receipt for 2022.

GUARDIAN ANGELS PARISH **OFFERTORY ENVELOPES**

As 2023 approaches, the Offertory envelopes for the New Year will soon be arriving. Over the past year, 180 boxes of envelopes have not been picked up by parishioners. As a result, we are limiting the number of boxes we will order for 2023. If your current envelope number is 1400 to 1500, you will be assigned a new number that will take effect as of January 1, 2023. Until then, your current number is to be used for any of your financial contributions until December 31, 2022. Your 2023 envelopes will include all of the regular Offertory envelopes plus the Building Fund and all of the Archdiocesan Second Collections. For all of the parishioners who contribute via the PAG program, you will no longer be getting a full box of Offertory envelopes. Instead, you will receive a small box of envelopes with Building Fund and all the extra Archdiocesan Second Collection envelopes. This allows you to more easily contribute to causes that are not covered by your PAG commitment.
